

### **GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Personal Safety**

#### **↑** DANGER

- Before you start using the equipment, you should consult your physician that this type of exercise is suitable for you from a health perspective.
- Note that excessive training can seriously endanger your health. If you notice any signs of weakness, nausea, dizziness, pain, shortness of breath, or other abnormal symptoms, stop exercising immediately and seek advice from your doctor if necessary.

### **MARNING**

- + This equipment may not be used by children under 14 years.
- + Children should not be allowed unsupervised access to the equipment
- + Persons with disabilities must have a medical license and must be under strict observation when using the equipment.
- + The equipment is strictly for use by one person at a time.

#### **↑** CAUTION

+ Make sure that nobody is within the range of motion of the equipment during training so as not to endanger you or other persons.

#### ► ATTENTION

+ Do not insert any objects of any kind into the openings of the device.

## **Set-Up Place**

### **↑** WARNING

- + Do not place the equipment in main corridors or escape routes.
- + To prevent fire, do not place the device near or in areas with high heat (e.g. near a heater).

### **∧** CAUTION

+ Choose the set-up place so that there is sufficient space around the product.

### ► ATTENTION

+ The device may only be used in one building, in sufficiently tempered and dry rooms (ambient temperatures between 10°C and 35°C). The equipment should not be used outdoors or in rooms with high humidity (over 70%) like swimming pools.

#### **Intended Use**

The equipment may only be used for its intended purpose.

The equipment is only suitable for home use. The equipment is not suitable for semi-professional (e.g. hospitals, associations, hotels, schools, etc.) and commercial or professional use (e.g. fitness studios).

### Assembly

### **^** CAUTION

- + Make sure to always use some sort of weight collar when exercising with external weights.
- + Never store unused weight plates on the floor.
- 1. Slide the desired weight plates onto the barbell bar one by one.
- 2. Attach a weight collar on each side to secure the weight plates from sliding off.
- 3. To unload the weight horn, take off the weight collar.
- 4. Slide each weight plate off of the weight horn with both hands one by one.

### **Training Manual**

Please read the training instructions carefully before starting your workout.

#### CAUTION

- + Only use weights appropriate for your fitness level.
- + Begin with light weights and increase gradually.
- 1. Grip the dumbbells in the middle of the handle.
- 2. Keep your back straight.

#### (i) NOTE

Avoid sudden or jerky movements.

3. Do not drop the dumbbells on the floor after completing a set.
